Rostec establishes a joint venture with Frequentis

The United Instrument Manufacturing Corporation and Frequentis A.G. (Austria) signed an agreement to establish a joint venture in Russia for the production of advanced voice communication and data transmission systems for air traffic control.

Production of the new equipment should begin within the next year at one of the manufacturing facilities of the United Instrument Manufacturing Corporation.

Frequentis AG signed an agreement of intent with the Sozvezdie Concern, a subsidiary of the United Instrument Manufacturing Corporation, in September 2013 at a meeting of the Russo-Austrian Business Council in Vienna. The current document is already legally binding: it prescribes the mutual obligations of the parties, and it specifies that the Russian partner is not a separate concern, but rather the United Instrument Manufacturing Corporation in its entirety. The details of the agreement and the procedure governing collaboration in organizing joint production between the parties will be discussed later.

Frequentis A.G. is a world leader in the development and production of modern digital unlockable systems for voice communication and data transmission that are used in areas such as air traffic control, railway and maritime transport, and the military and civilian spheres when establishing command-and-control management centers, including in the field of public safety.

OAO United Instrument Manufacturing Corporation is a Russian state corporation that was created in 2014 by the Rostec State Corporation to establish high-tech production of competitive products in the fields of technology and communications systems, automated control systems, and electronic warfare and robotic systems for the Russian Armed Forces and other special units, as well as competitive products for civilian and dual-use. The corporation includes the Vega Radio Engineering Corporation, the Sozvezdie Concern, the Management Systems integrated structure and the Central Research Institute of Economics, Informatics and Control Systems. The corporation unites 55 enterprises and research organizations in the Russian radio electronics industry, employing a total of 39,500 people.
